

Request for a voluntary gambling exclusion

I hereby request a voluntary exclusion. I acknowledge that the following conditions apply to this voluntary exclusion pursuant to Art. 80 and Art. 81 of the Swiss Federal Act on Gambling (GA). **In accordance with the bilateral agreement between Switzerland and the Principality of Liechtenstein, this voluntary exclusion is also valid in the Principality of Liechtenstein.**

- The exclusion is valid for an indefinite period of time and has no fixed expiry date.
- The exclusion extends to all games on offer at all Swiss casinos in bricks-and-mortar casinos, online casinos and casinos in the Principality of Liechtenstein.
- The exclusion also applies to online lotteries, to sports betting and skill games, as well as to major games determined by the intercantonal authority. This means that the exclusion also applies, for example, to participation in the online Swiss Lotto and other games offered by Swisslos and Loterie Romande.
- A termination request can be submitted after three months at the earliest and requires a financial review by means of the provided documents, as well as a face-to-face meeting with a representative of a counselling office recognised by the canton.

This centre offers advice, support and therapy to help affected individuals and their families find alternatives to casinos and gaming. The expert counsellors listen, ask questions and offer guidance to persons in the process of trying to change their gaming behaviour. The advisory service is free and non-binding.
